WHEREAS, sealed bids were received for the Court Games Resurfacing at Ammann Park and Votee Park and read in public on February 5, 2013, following public advertisement as required by law and in accordance with specifications therefor; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received, one from All Surface Asphalt Paving, Inc., 528 Hardenberg Avenue, Point Pleasant, New Jersey 08742 and one from Halecon, Inc., 136 Billian Street, Bridgewater, New Jersey 08807, as more particularly set forth on the recapitulation of bids annexed hereto and made part hereof; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated February 7, 2013, All Surface Asphalt Paving, Inc. advised the Township of an error in its bid proposal by failing to include the resurfacing of four tennis courts in it base bid and has requested to withdraw its bid pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.3; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer, the Twp.'s Purchasing Agent, the Township Manager and the Consulting Engineer have reviewed the bid submitted by All Surface Asphalt Paving and have recommended to the Township Council that All Surface Asphalt Paving be permitted to withdrawn its bid on the basis that a mistake, as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2, was made, that enforcement of the contract, if actually made, would be unconscionable, that the mistake relates to a material feature of the bid; that the mistake occurred notwithstanding the fact that the bidder exercised reasonable care in preparation of its bid and that the bid of All Surface Asphalt Paving can get relief from the mistake by withdrawing its bid without serious prejudice to the Township of Teaneck, except for the loss of the bargain to the Township of Teaneck; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer, Purchasing Agent and Consulting Engineer, Kinsey Associates, recommend, and the Township Manager agrees, that a contract for this project be awarded to the next lowest responsive responsible bidder, Halecon, Inc., 136 Billian Street, Bridgewater, New Jersey 08807, based on a base bid cost of \$289,329.59, Alternate 1A - \$200.00, Alternate 1B - \$2,600.00, Alternate 1C - \$1,800.00, Alternate 1D - \$500.00, Alternate 2 - \$11,656.70, with a contingency of \$30,013.71, for a total cost not to exceed \$336,100.00; and






AMMANN PARK TENNIS COURTS

PROPOSED RENOVATIONS

A. LAYOUT - Proposed layout is predicated on existing fence lines

- The Contractor shall remove designated sections of existing chain link perimeter fence fabric complete with ties, hardware and appurtenances. (Alternate Bid #2) The Contractor shall carefully remove, preserve and reinstall all signage mounted on fence sections that are designated for removal and replacement.

- and replacement.

 The Contractor shall remove existing tennis court accessories complete with ground sleeves and footings.

 The Contractor shall perform all pavement preparation:

 a) The Contractor shall mill/profile the tennis court pavement to an average depth of 2 ½" to 3" below proposed finished grades. Miller/profiler shall be laser controlled to insure uniformity of base pavement grade.
 - Where court accessories have been removed, and will not be replaced at the exact location, compact select fill to 95% Standard Proctor Density to 4" below milled pavement grade and cap with 4" HMABC or 3000 psi concrete.
- c) Clean out all cracks and/or joints and/or fissures full depth and fill with size #10 stone dust, concrete sand, HMASC (1-6), or Portland cement grout. All infill shall be fully consolidated.

 Excavation resultant from demolition shall be backfilled with select material and compacted to 95% Standard

C. COURT ACCESSORIES

- Contractor shall construct two (2) net post sleeves in footings, two (2) posts, and one net per court, See detail 6/E and specifications
- 2. Contractor shall construct one (1) center anchor per court, see detail 6/F and specifications.

D. PAVEMENT CONSTRUCTION

- Contractor shall apply a pavement reinforcement mastic bandage to all exposed cracks or joints in the profiled surface.

 Contractor shall apply a pavement reinforcement fabric to the entire pavement surface to
- be overlaid. (Alternate Bid #1).

 Contractor shall construct any necessary leveling or patching on the profiled surface.

 Contractor shall tack coat all surfaces to be overlaid.
- Contractor shall construct a uniform 2 1/2"- 3" (two lifts) layer HMASC over the prepared profiled pavement surface,
 Contractor shall construct expansion joints where indicated on plan,

- Subsequent to proper curing of the overlay, the Contractor shall construct the colorcoating. Proposed final grades may be nominally adjusted in the field to accommodate existing conditions and if approved by the Consultant.

E. COURT FINISHING

Contractor shall construct colorcoating and linestriping for four tennis courts as shown on plan and on detail 6/H and in specifications.

F. SITE RESTORATION

- Contractor shall construct a 4' wide x 6" thick topsoil transition with sod finish around court bank perimeter (see specifications).
- All other disturbed areas (turf, pavement, landscaping, etc.) shall be returned to existing or better condition. See specifications.

G. PERIMETER FENCE (ALTERNATE BID)



 Contractor shall construct 392+ f. LF of 10-0" high chain link fence fabric on the existing fence posts.

 Contractor shall remove and reset any out of plumb or out of alignment posts. Contractor shall remove and replace any bent posts, and reastemble framework. Allow 8 in bid. See detail 7/D and specifications.

 Contractor shall construct 5' x 5' access pad at proposed 5'-0" wide pedestrian access gates and 10' x 10' access pad at 10'-0" utility gate. See detail 6/G.

 The Contractor shall carefully remove, preserve and reinstall all signage mounted on fence sections that are designated for removal and replacement.


