Re: 189 The Plaza

Comments: These are areas that need to be addressed for this project:

- 1) During demolition, excavation, construction, etc., require dust control, rodent and pest control measures, and soil erosion preventative measures
- 2) Trash storage area and recycling storage container area required
- 3) Port-o-Johns must be maintained and sanitary at all times
- 4) Specific plans provided to Health Department for retail food areas, laundry, spa and pool, sauna, etc (with appropriate fees)
- All plumbing to be in compliance with Plumbing UCC Code (Building Dept.)
- 6) All retail food, bathing, vending, housing rental, laundry, etc. require licensing from the Health Department, with appropriate fees (Health Dept. to be contacted for specifics)
- Air conditioner units, generators, compressors, etc. to have approval and be in compliance with Twp. Noise Code (Section 21)
- 8) All residential rental units to be registered, fees paid and inspected prior to occupancy
- 9) Since it is a multiple family dwelling, must be registered with NJ State DCA
- 10) Health Department to be contacted by GC or project Manager with questions to the above (201-837-1600 ext. 1500)
